Footprint	80 × 80 cm

MATERIALS

- Marble back and sides, rounded corners
- Wooden seat, projecting at the rear
- Brass inlays at the joint between seat and back
- Steel profile following the line of the back

FINISHES

Polished · honed · antiqued. Choosing the finish is a maintenance decision before an aesthetic one.

DESIGN NOTES

The name comes from joinery: the tenon is the projection that enters the mortise. Here the joint is declared rather than hidden, and the brass inlay marks it.

LEAD TIME

Six to eight weeks from order.

PRICE ON APPLICATION

Dimensions refer to the standard design. Every work is made to measure: size, stone and finish are defined with the project.
